### Volunteer Mentor Job Description

<b>Title:</b>	Volunteer Mentor
<b>Purpose:</b>	Be a role model to a special needs child or the sibling of a special needs child.
<b>Qualifications:</b>	Must like to spend time with children (age range 6 to 18) and have patience and perseverance.
<b>Time Commitment:</b>	Two hours per week or four hours every other week for one year
<b>Location:</b>	Throughout Santa Clara County and beyond. Visit a child at his/her residence and participate in activities out in the community.
<b>Responsibilities:</b>	Meet with child on a regular basis. Maintain consistent contact with mentee and family. If possible, attend Family Team Meetings. Attend three mentor support meetings per year.
<b>Training &amp; Support:</b>	Attend one six-hour mentor training. Monthly mentor support meetings.
<b>Benefits:</b>	Satisfaction in making a difference in the life of a child. Meeting other people with similar interests. May attend EMQ staff training. Free tickets to sporting and entertainment events.
<b>Supervision:</b>	Program Staff and/or EMQ FamiliesFirst Mentor Program Staff.
<b>Screening Process:</b>	Orientation & Interview, Proof of Auto Insurance, Copy of Driver's License, Criminal Background Check through LiveScan, current copy of DMV Driving record printout and three references.
